SCHOOL RULES (1)



When the accumulated deduction points reach 10 points, the participant will be expelled.

I. Rules:

- 1. Late for class: 0.5 points will be deducted for each late arrival.
- 2. Course Absence: 1 point will be deducted for each unasked absence.
- 3. Failure to comply with the code of conduct: 1 point will be deducted for bad behavior such as being impolite, disrespectful, and uncooperative, and the teacher will issue a physical complaint.
- 4. Violation of going out: Underage students are not allowed to go out alone. If they go out without reporting, 3 points will be deducted.
- 5. Property damage: 2-5 points will be deducted for intentional or negligent damage to other people's property or school facilities. The specific number of points depends on the degree of damage. The teacher will provide physical evidence. .
- 6. Violation of prohibited items: 2 points will be deducted for carrying prohibited items, such as alcohol, cigarettes, etc. The specific number of points will be determined according to the nature and degree of danger of the items.
- 7. Violation of the dress code: 1 point will be deducted for violating the dress code specified by the battalion.
- 8. Violation of curfew regulations: Failure to return to the dormitory within the designated time will result in 3.5 points being deducted. The specific number of points will be deducted based on the violation.
- 9. Violation of dietary restrictions: Violation of specific dietary restrictions may result in a deduction of 1-3 points, depending on the violation and the severity of the restriction.

SCHOOL RULES (2)



- 10. Violation of the use of electronic devices: The school will distribute mobile phones from 9 to 10 p.m. from Monday to Friday, and collect mobile phones at 10 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays. Violation of the restrictions on the use of personal electronic devices will deduct 1 point.
- 11. Internet usage: Violating the camp's restrictions on Internet use, including accessing inappropriate websites, spreading inappropriate content, etc., 1 point will be deducted.
- 12. Sleep time and rest regulations: Violating sleep time and rest regulations, such as not complying with bedtime, disturbing others' rest, etc., will result in 1 point deducted.
- 13. Violation of electricity regulations: Failure to turn off the air conditioner and lights when going out will result in 2 points deducted.
- 14. Violation of personal hygiene regulations: Failure to comply with personal hygiene requirements, such as not washing hands, not sorting personal belongings, etc., will result in a deduction of 1 point.
- 15. Violation of moral norms: Violations of basic moral norms, such as stealing, lying, fighting, bullying, etc., will result in 3-5 points being deducted. The specific number of points will be deducted based on the violation and the severity of the behavior.
- 16. Violation of activity arrangements and timetables: Violations of the camp's activity arrangements and timetables, such as failure to participate in activities on time, missing designated gathering times, etc., will result in 1-2 points being deducted. The specific number of points will be deducted according to
- 17. Entering the room of the opposite sex: It is prohibited to enter the room of the opposite sex under any circumstances. If violated, 5 points will be deducted.

REFUND POLICY



- Refund application deadline: Students must submit a refund application two weeks before the start of the semester, otherwise they will not receive a full refund.
- Refund amount:
- If a student applies for a refund two weeks before the arrival date, a full refund will be given, but the registration fee will not be refunded.
- If a student applies for a refund within two weeks of arriving at school, 80% of the fee will be refunded, and the registration fee will not be refunded.
- If a student applies for refund less than 25% of the total weeks of study, 50% of the fee will be refunded.
- If a student applies for a refund within 25% to 50% of the total number of weeks of study, 20% of the fee will be refunded.
- If a student applies for refund after more than 50% of the total weeks of study, the fee will not be refunded.
- Refund procedure: Students need to fill in a formal refund application form and provide relevant supporting documents. The school will process the refund within 30 working days after receiving the application.
- Non-refundable items: Fees that students must bear by themselves, such as registration fees, textbook fees and other related fees, will not be refunded.
- Refund method: Tuition fees will be refunded to the original method of payment, unless otherwise specified by the student.
