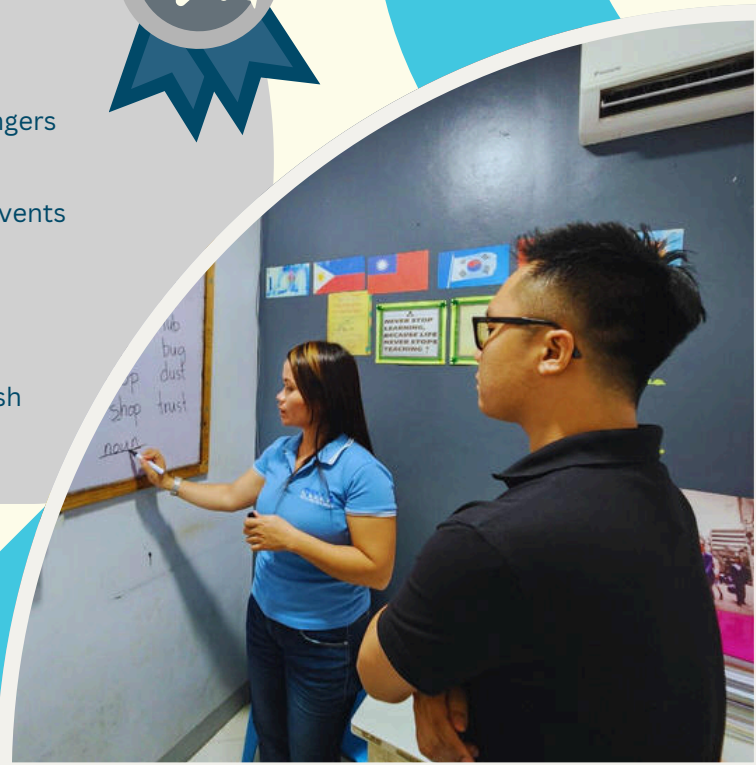
This language fosters trust and comfort, creating a secure and enjoyable travel experience while ensuring airline personnel can perform their duties effectively.
