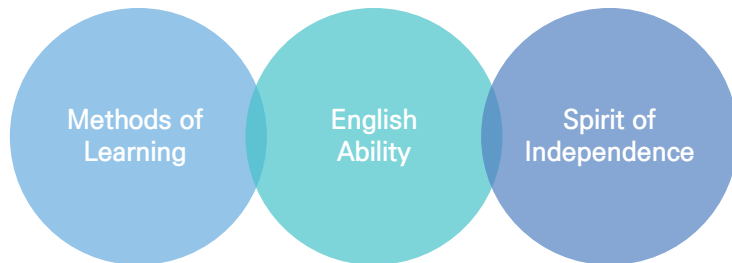

3 Unique qualities of CIDEC International Campus

01

For Long-Term Study

Instead of short-term stay to study English during vacation periods only, students can stay more than 1~2 years and return to their school in their homeland at an appropriate or in advance grade level.

02

For School Transfer

Students who plan to enroll to their school of choice but need time to improve their English skills and wait for the school opening/ admission schedule. Students are able to transfer to their target school after improving their English ability and adjust in studying different school subjects without time restriction within 1~2 years.

03

For Studying Abroad

CIDEC students can have an opportunity to study in a foreign university faster within 1~2 years advance compared to other students through the CIDEC modular program. They will be able to get a high school diploma and can obtain an English score from IELTS or TOEFL at the same time.

CIDEC's Completion of the School Year

- Students who are not satisfied with short-term training during vacation.
- Students who want to take mid-and long-term training for about one year but hesitate because of the school registration.
- Students who want to improve their Academic English proficiency besides ESL based English skills.

CIDEC's Early-Transfer

- Students who have to go to their selected/ targeted school to enter but need a period of adjustment such as improving English skills or adjusting to Philippines' school subjects.
- Students who cannot enter a school in time for admission period in Philippines, which usually starts in June and August.
- Students who feel uncomfortable with face-to-face learning due to age, introvert personality or physical problems.

CIDEC's Foreign University Entrance

- Students who are in High school or have no clear goals for their career.
- A student who is a late bloomer that is not in harmony with their own country's competitive education system.
- Students who have a goal to go to a foreign university instead of a university in their own country.



After studying the Philippines based school subjects and completion of relevant school year, students return to a school in Korea at an age-appropriate grade level
Ex) Grade 2 → CIDEC G3 → when returning to Korea, Grade 4



After improvement of English skills and adapting to the Philippine education curriculum, students transfer to their targeted prestigious schools at age-appropriate grade level



After having a high school diploma and obtaining an English score from an authorized test, a student can enter to an Asian or English-speaking Universities.

※ Before the start of the course, the student must confirm with schools where he/she is planning to return after the completion of a grade in the Philippines if they accept him/her at age-appropriate grade level since it is at every principal's own discretion.

So I will recommend a school that helped me improve my knowledge and skills in just 1 year. This is CIEC, the best school for junior, in Cebu City Philippines.

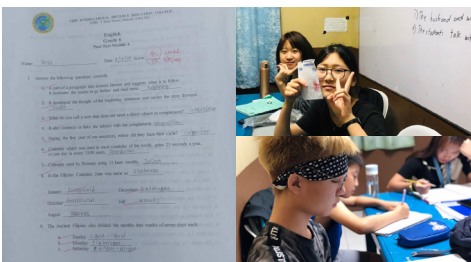
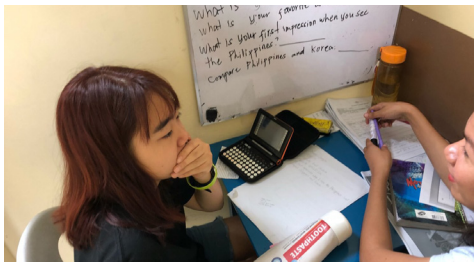
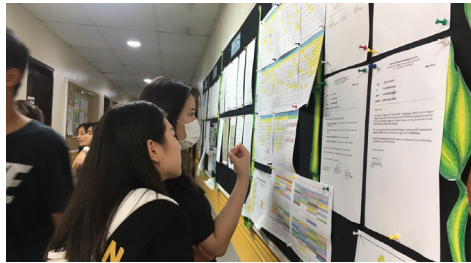
