Students bring marine life to the canvas through hands-on painting.

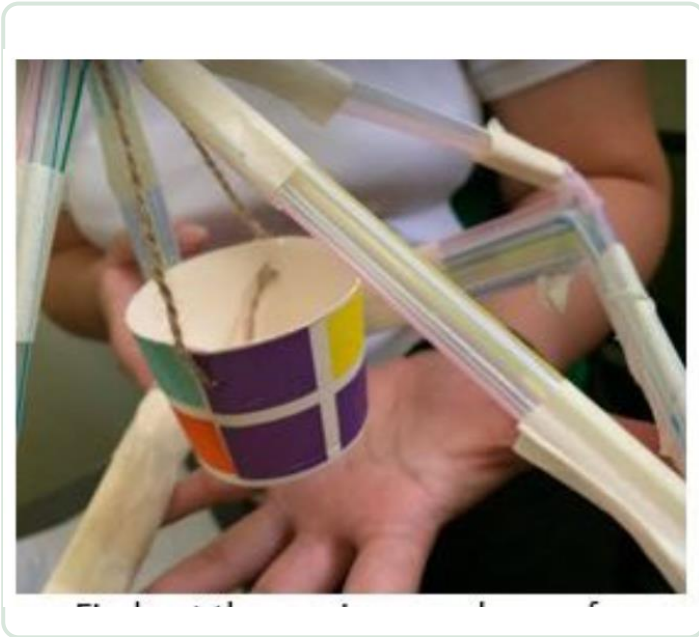

Schedule Tour & Assessment

Required for children age 4+ (₱1,000 fee).

We'll confirm your schedule once payment proof is received.

Good to know: School assessments are required for children ages 4 and above, to help us understand the student's starting level.

Prepare Required Documents

- 3 pieces of 2"x 2" ID Photo of student (recent and with white background)
- 1 piece of 2"x2" ID Photo each parent (any color background)
- Passport details
 - Photocopy of child's passport (Bio Page and Visa Information)
 - Photocopy of each parent's passport (Bio Page)
 - Copy of Visa of parent/ guardian
 - Complete school report cards from previous school/s from Kindergarten until most recent grade level
 - Required School Forms

Have the student's documents ready — we'll walk you through the full checklist of required school forms.
